
SERVICE INFORMATION

SUBJECT: 1981 UNI-TRAK SHOCK ABSORBER REPAIR

NOTE: Only the aluminum body shocks are serviceable.

There are two types of aluminum body shocks used on the '81 Uni-Trak machines. Both shocks are nitrogen charged deCarbon type, which means there is a floating piston separating the oil from the gas pressure.

- KX machines feature a remote reservoir with the floating piston inside the reservoir.
- KDX models have the floating piston inside the shock body.

It is this difference in construction that makes the KDX250/420 shock dangerous to disassemble and why the Owner's/Service Manual states it is not rebuildable.

To provide greater customer satisfaction, Kawasaki has established a factory trained and approved Service Center for the KDX250/420 shock absorbers.

KDX services available are oil change, limited repair and addition of a remote reservoir to give the same increased oil capacity and fade resistant performance as the KX shocks. The Service Center will also rebuild KX shocks for those dealers not wishing to perform repairs. Kawasaki feels this service will help to keep your customers happy with their Uni-Trak machines and, in addition, add profits to your dealership.

NOTE: For optimum performance, the oil in the Uni-Trak shock should be changed at these recommended intervals:

- After an initial break-in period of 15 hours.
- Every six races or when the dampening rate decreases.


